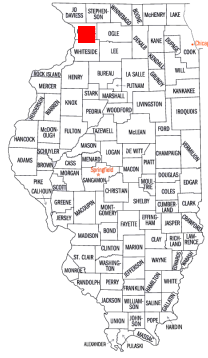

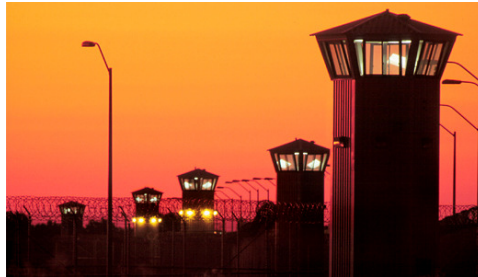

# Illinois Maximum Security Correctional Center

Thomson, Illinois



The campus style 1600-cell Maximum Security Correctional Facility is located in Thomson, Illinois. The pneumatic technology provided a substantial cost savings to the state. This was the first facility in Illinois history to use pneumatic locks and sliding devices.

Norment furnished and installed security and non-security hollow metal, Airteq pneumatic and mechanical security hardware, finish hardware, security mesh and accessories. Additionally, Norment's Trentech division performed the engineering, programming and installation of the complex security control system. The integrated system consisted of Locking Control, Intercom, CCTV, Perimeter Detection, Access Control systems monitored and controlled on Touchscreen consoles and Graphic Panels via Programmable Logic Controllers.
